1	Availability of Application Forms The PGDM course application forms are available on the business school's official website. Prospective candidates can apply online (https://sanjivanisbs.org.in/) or request the link by calling the school directly.	Ongoing
2	Application Submission Deadline All completed application forms and the required documents must be submitted online by this date. Late applications may not be accepted. Please use the online medium; do not send hard copies of your documents to SBS.	To be announced
3	Entrance Exam (Can also be taken after the provisional admission is granted). Qualifying in any one of the following tests: CAT, XAT, CMAT, ATMA, MAT, GMAT, MH-MBA/MMS CET is mandatory. The SBS being a member of the Association of Indian Management Schools (AIMS), highly recommends prospective candidates to apply for the third round of the ATMA test to be held on 23.07.2023 (https://atmaaims.com/) Your score might also make you eligible for a 10%-40% of discount on Tuition Fees. 4	Application Screening and Shortlisting The SBS selection committee will review the applications and shortlist candidates (on a rolling basis) based on their academic records, entrance exam scores, quality of work experience (if required), and other relevant criteria. Shortlisted candidates are notified through email or phone who will appear for an online Interview session with expert faculty.	On a Rolling basis







5	Online Personal Interview Shortlisted candidates are invited for online personal interview assessment and screening. The personal interview assesses the candidate's communication skills, personality traits, critical thinking, and motivation for pursuing the PGDM course. Provisional admission is offered based on your performance in online Interviews,	On a rolling basis
6	quality of application and scores in competitive exams. Announcement of Final Selection The SBS will declare the list of candidates who have been selected for admission to the PGDM course. A few of the quality candidates will be kept on the wait-list. The list is published on the official website and notice boards and sent to the selected candidates through email or post. 7	Fee Payment and Confirmation Selected candidates must pay the requisite admission fees to secure their seats within this period. Failure to submit the fees on time may result in the offer of admission being withdrawn.	To be Announced
